Wrap cardigans are popular right now and easy to accessorize. You can sew them with long sleeves or short sleeves, and layer them over a tank.

I've been wanting to make a wrap suit for a while, so I didn't put it off and started as soon as I got Akira's pattern and fabric. It's perfect for late pregnancy and will be equally comfortable for me postpartum as the trousers have a drawtring fastening.





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This outfit is suitable for any occasion and any type of figure. It will help you look stylish and elegant, as well as feel comfortable and confident.

There are many things to love about the [Akira pattern](#). It is a quick sew, gives you coverage of the rear (but can be made in shorter lengths), and can be worn in several seasons.

I chose the option of a long cardigan and trousers. This makes it possible to use them as separate parts and combine them with other things from the wardrobe.



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I chose the [4C22 Rustic Black Fs Premier Finish fabric – 100% Linen – Heavy](#) and I am very pleased with how this color looks in this set.

This project is for beginners who want to learn to do a simple pattern transformation.

You can sew this suit very quickly, since the pattern is quite simple and does not require any special skills.







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I like how the finished garment feels and fits.

I would love to try the shorter length of cardigan view next time.

I really liked making this pattern and I think it could be customized for a variety of looks, for example its possible to play with colour or a type of fabric. Enjoy!
