Description





The <u>AKIRA Pant</u> in Midweight <u>DUSTY LOTUS</u> linen was my first completed project. I searched for a simple drawstring pant pattern for months and finally landed on this pattern set. I fell in love with the Dusty Lotus green when Fabrics-store first launched it, knowing I wanted to make a pair of pants and a matching linen tank from it someday. Finally, that day arrived and I sewed this beautiful pair of pants on a Tuesday morning next to a frozen lake, snow falling outside my window, a fire crackling, while I dreamed of the summer days when I will be wearing them most.





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I'm loving this pattern design for its comfortability and versatility. The wide leg and drawstring closure remind me of pajama pants, in a good way. They are perfect for lounging with a pair of wool socks in these colder months. And, because of the beautiful drape and texture of linen, this design can be easily dressed-up with a sweater, fleece leggings underneath, and boots (my trick to wearing linen in the winter). They truly are a pant that can transition from day to night, which is so important to me living with a capsule wardrobe. The green color is best I have found and reminds me of those snowy white pines that hug the shore of the lakes all over the northwoods. Forever my favorite.





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Next on my sewing list is a matching linen tank and the <u>AKIRA jacket</u> in a natural linen to complete this outfit.
